











- Remove the breathing valve.
- Remove accessories that must not be machine cleaned (eg electronics).



• Close the hatch (if applicable).




- Put masks/helmets in the washing bag.
- Close it carefully and lock it with the four cord locks.
- Preferably wash the maximum number of masks/helmets specified by the washing machine manufacturer (normally 6-14 masks/helmet).




Check:

- Sufficient PPE Decon Detergent.
- Sufficient PPE Decon Disinfectant.
- Water supply open.
- Special wash program for Interspiro products (max 50° C) selected.




Disinfection step

- Dose 0.5% PPE Decon Disinfectant in a separate step after the cleaning step but before rinsing.
- Temperature: 40 °C
- Time: 15 minutes




- Remove the mask/helmet from the washing bag and shake off excess water.
- Check that the mask is clean.
 If necessary, re-wash the mask or finish washing it manually.



- Open the hatch (if applicable).
- Let the mask dry.
- In a drying cabinet, maximum 2 hours at 55 °C applies. (proper drying counteracts the growth of bacteria and mold).

- The washing bags can be spun to accelerate drying.
- When drying in a drying cabinet, a maximum of 55 °C applies.
